Natural Consequences happen on their own. For a child who forgot their sweater, being cold is their natural consequence.

Logical consequences are deliberate and enforced by you. It is ideal for the child to know the consequences beforehand. A child who refuses to eat dinner, would not get dessert or a snack before bed.
