Dear Parent or Guardian:

Florida Statute 1003.22 requires each child who is entitled to admittance to kindergarten, or any other initial entrance into Florida public school to present a certificate of immunization for the prevention of those communicable diseases for which immunization is required, a school-entry health examination performed within one year prior to enrollment in school is also required by the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services.

The statute further requires these documents prior to enrollment and prohibits a school from admitting a student, regardless of grade level, who does not comply with the law. Further, the statute makes parents or guardians of school children responsible for compliance with the law.

The law does provide for a school to issue a temporary 30-day exemption for a student transferring from another state or country in order to allow time for the transfer of records.

Through a copy of this letter signed and dated by your school principal, you are hereby granted a temporary 30-day exemption as provided by law. However, by your signature on a copy of this letter you are acknowledging that your child will be excused from further attendance after the date indicated if the proper records of certification are not on file at the school.
